The *Pay it Forward Tour* is a college spring break road trip based on the idea of paying goodness *forward* instead of asking for favors *back*.

In charter buses of 40 people, hundreds travel from the Midwest to Washington DC and San Antonio, stopping at major cities along the way doing different service projects in each city.

This year, there will be 15 Tours with 600 participants, serving nearly 9,000 hours in 77 communities.
